



Paris Pact Initiative (UNODC global programme GLOY09)

In recent years, drug control and drug demand reduction efforts have become even more complex and new drug threats have continued evolving (methamphetamine) along the main drug trafficking routes originating in Afghanistan.

In 2022, pursuing more effective responses to the operational challenges, partners joined in Paris Pact Initiative's events in large numbers emphasizing country-driven demand for the partnership, confirming Paris Pact's strategic position as unique platform, and the need for its continued strengthening in line with the Vienna Declaration and CND Res 56/3.

Paris Pact global programme (GLOY09) of UNODC coordinates the partnership enhancing synergies and cooperation between Paris Pact's 58 partner countries and 23 partner organizations.
