

Paris Pact Initiative (UNODC global programme GLOY09)

In recent years, **drug control and drug demand reduction efforts** have become even **more complex** and **new drug threats** have continued evolving (methamphetamine) along the main drug trafficking routes originating in Afghanistan.

In 2022, pursuing **more effective responses** to the operational challenges, **partners joined in Paris Pact Initiative's events in large numbers** emphasizing **country-driven demand** for the partnership, confirming Paris Pact's strategic position as **unique platform**, and the **need for its continued strengthening** in line with the **Vienna Declaration** and **CND Res 56/3**.

Paris Pact global programme (GLOY09) of UNODC coordinates the partnership enhancing **synergies** and **cooperation** between **Paris Pact's 58 partner countries** and **23 partner organizations**.
