### Expert Working Group on Community-based and Outpatient Treatment

The two-day event brought together 37 participants representing 15 countries and 3 international organisations and coincided with the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, on 26 June 2015. The EWG corresponded to Pillar IV (Reducing drug abuse and dependence through a comprehensive approach) of the Vienna Declaration, adopted at the Third Ministerial Conference of the Paris Pact Partners in February 2012, which serves as the roadmap to guide all partner actions in support to the Initiative and guiding Paris Pact partners' action throughout its Phase IV (2013-2016).
